5. Next Steps for Private Lending REA Rules

The Chair received several emails in response to the July 6/22 Review of Private Lending (PL) Mortgage Brokering Rules discussion.

Participants contemplated licensing eligibility criteria and mandatory education to increase professionalism in the private lending sector. Disclosure requirements and forms could increase borrower and lender confidence and decrease consumer harm. Participants would like the terms *syndicated mortgages, Mortgage Investment Corporations* (MICs) and *individual private lenders* to be defined. Statistics relating to the number of error and omissions claims resulting from private lending activity were requested.

The Industry Council concurred that right-touch regulation involves the reduction of red tape. The Industry Council will consult with stakeholders, virtually and in person, on an aide for brokers of record and a form to reduce conflicts of interest and improve disclosure.
